- Routes de France, Chardonnay 2022, Languedoc, France** 16 | 60
The first impression of this Chardonnay screams 'oak, flowers, peaches, vanilla'. On the palate, it's buttery, with plenty of tropical fruit and a hint of brioche.
- L Orso Talamonti, Pecorino 2022, Abruzzo, Italy.** 19 | 80
On the palate; nice acidity and a distinct fruity character reminiscent of ripe pears or apples, with a longer aftertaste with hints of jasmine or white flowers.
- Wolftrap, Viognier - Chenin Blanc 2022, Franschhoek, South Africa.** 19 | 80
An enticing aroma of green apple and lemon along with notes of white flowers. The wine tastes a bit creamy and oaky on the palate with tons of rich flavors.
- Babich, Sauvignon Blanc 2023, Marlborough, New Zealand.** 21 | 105
Aromas of tropical fruits and lime. Shows stone fruits with passionfruit, blackcurrant, and grapefruit on the palate.
- Calvet, Aligoté 2023, Burgundy, France.** 95
Attractive nose of white fruit and citrus. The palate Very fresh, precise palate, with and a delicate, tart finish
- Fontanafredda, Gavi di Gavi 2022, Serralunga d'Alba, Italy.** 110
The bouquet of this wine will have your mouth watering before the first sip. Very floral, citrus zest, and vanilla aromas. The wine is dry, full, and elegant.
- Tiefenbrunner, Pinot Grigio 2022, Südtirol, Italy.** 110
This top-of-the-line Pinot Grigio has aromas of citrus, white blossoms, pears, apples, and meadow grass. There is a fresh, crisp minerality and a clear finish.

- Villa Wolf, Pinot Noir, Pfalz, Germany** Fruity aromas of cherry's and other red fruit. Beautiful acidity and slight smokyness. **19 | 80**
- Danzante, Sangiovese 2022, Chianti, Italy.** **19 | 80**
has an intense ruby red colour. The bouquet is characterised by elegant floral notes, such as violet and hints of red fruits
- Moda Talamonti, Montepulciano 2022, Abruzzo, Italy** **20 | 90**
Full and round. Typical purple hue from this Montepulciano, with lofty aromas of cherry, prunes, and raspberry.
- Zenato, Corvina - Corvinone - Rondinella, Valpolicella 2020, Italy.** **110**
This beautifully balanced Valpolicella is always a good idea. On the nose delicate red fruit: wild berries, cherries, and spices. This wine has mild tannins.
- Gerard Bertrand Saint Victor, Pinot Noir 2022, Roussillon-Languedoc, France.** **110**
A fruity and juicy pinot noir with a slight hint of pepper. Very soft tannins make for a beautifully structured wine. Notes of cherries and raspberries and a fruity aftertaste.
- Venta las Vacas, Tempranillo 2020, Ribera del Duero, Spain.** **125**
Beautiful nose of soft fruit, and some floral notes. On the palate fruit expressions as well as some oak. Mature tannins and a long round finish.
- Canvasback, Cabernet Sauvignon 2019, Washington State, United States.** **145**
Aromas of blackberry, cassis, and lavender. The palate continues the black fruit trend, while flavors of wild herbs, truffle, and earth add complexity
- Cosseti, Barbera D'asti 2020, Piemonte, Italy.** **145**
Terrific red wine from the Piemonte region with acidity, earthiness and a deep color. Pairs beautifully with grilled meats.
- Condé Stark, Syrah 2018, Stellenbosch, South Africa.** **150**
